

COVID-19 Pandemic Protocol – M.I.A.D.F. Consent Form

The studio will be implementing the following strict protocol for our dancers, families and staff. Please sign and return consent form for each dancer.

Arrival/Departure

- 1. Upon arrival to studio, please observe social distancing guidelines as you approach the entrance. If there are more than 8 people waiting to be checked in, please be considerate of the time required to check in dancers and return when line is less crowded. Spaces will be marked to enter and exit the studio meeting social distancing guidelines.
- 2. All parents may drop off their child but will NOT be allowed to wait inside the studio.
- 3. All dancers will have their temperature taken at the door before entering the studio. If a dancer has a temperature at or above the <u>CDC Guideline</u> of 100.4° F (38° C), the dancer will be kindly asked to return after 14 days. They may return after 5 minutes to have it retaken. Should it still remain at or above the CDC Guideline, they will kindly be asked to return after 14 days.
- 4. If dancer does not have a fever but does show other signs of a cold and/or COVID-19 symptoms (shortness of breath, loss of sense of taste or smell, dry cough, runny nose, sore throat), dancer will be kindly asked to return after 14 days.
- 5. Outside shoes will be removed at the door. They will be disinfected and placed in a bin provided individually for each dancer. Dancers can change into socks at the door or walk barefoot. They will take classes in socks or barefoot except for Hip-Hop and Ballet. Hip-Hop shoes should be brought in a separate clear bag. Ballet/Pointe shoes should be brought in a separate clear bag. They will be disinfected before class begins. Hip-Hop classes will be held in the same studio.
- 6. Only Hip-Hop and/or Ballet shoes, phone and a water bottle will be allowed. No other bags or personal items will be allowed inside the studio. Water bottles should be brought in a clear bag. Hop-Hop and Ballet shoes, phone and water bottle will be disinfected before being placed in each dancer's individual bin.
- 7. Car lines will be the required method of pick-up after class is over.
- 8. When class is over, a studio employee will bring dancer(s) to their parent's car in the car line. In order to move the car line quickly, please remain in your car and do not use this time to ask the studio employee questions. Questions can be answered by emailing studio. Please be patient.

Note: This protocol will be in place until the studio feels the pandemic situation is controlled (even if the County states otherwise).

COVID-19 Pandemic Protocol – M.I.A.D.F. Consent Form (cont'd)

Class Attire/Studio Requirements

- 1. Masks Dancers must wear a mask when they enter the studio and it must be worn throughout class no exceptions. Dancers may wear their own mask from home, or a disposable mask will be provided by studio. Masks with the M.I.A.D.F. logo will be available for purchase email your order (<u>miadancefactory@gmail.com</u>) and the mask will be provided at the next class. Please wash your mask daily at home before returning to class the following day.
- 2. Individual Bins Each dancer will be provided their own plastic bin to place their phone, water bottle, Hip-Hop shoes, Ballet/pointe shoes and outside shoes after each of these items mentioned are disinfected. This bin will be taken by each dancer to their studio to be placed against the wall, socially distant apart. Plastic bins will be disinfected after each use.
- 3. Dance Attire Clothing should be a leotard and leggings or dance shorts (Company Members should wear their M.I.A.D.F. uniform). To allow for more dance time, dancers will be allowed to wear the same outfit they enter the studio with for all class sessions. Changing will not be required.
- 4. Class Time Classes will run between 45-50 minutes to allow time for check-in, check-out of dancers and to clean studios. Studios will be cleaned and sanitized before and after every class. Barres will be wiped down and the Hip-Hop studio floor will be quickly mopped. Door handles and bathrooms will be wiped throughout class time.
- 5. Class sizes Depending on each studio, class sizes will be between 6-12 dancers, in order to keep everyone socially distant.
- 6. Bathrooms Please ensure that every dancer makes a bathroom trip at home before arriving to the studio. Bathrooms will be disinfected throughout the day and after each use by a dancer/staff member. Reinforce at home the importance of washing hands with soap before leaving the bathroom.
- 7. Food/Water Water fountain will be turned off. Snacks and ice cream can be purchased and eaten only AFTER class <u>outside of the studio building</u>. Purchases will be charged to your account to avoid money exchange.
- 8. Dancer Discretion Company Members should not feel the pressure of 'missing' class if they are feeling ill. Your health and well-being are more important to us please be honest to protect yourself and others.

I understand the above new studio pandemic protocol, and I agree to comply in order to protect myself and our studio family. I knowingly and willingly consent to allow the dancer to attend in-studio dance classes and that M.I.A.D.F. is not liable should any dancer contract the COVID-19 virus.
